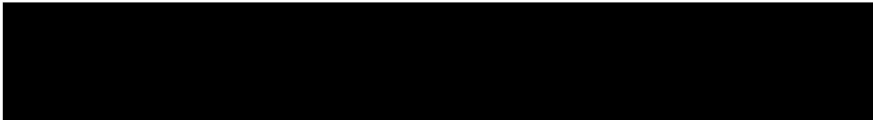

Your comments on the planning application

The proposed building is highly likely to have a beneficial impact on patients at the Royal Free Hospital and beyond through research into transplants and common diseases such as arthritis and cancer. Its location at the hospital is important for the translation of laboratory advances into clinical practice.

In my opinion, the design of the building improves the appearance of the western aspect of the hospital by partly shielding the old facade.

Having worked at the hospital for 20 years, I can see that the scheme's separation of pedestrian and vehicular access from the south (e.g. from Belsize Park underground station) will improve safety and convenience for disabled and others who are traversing the western facade of the proposed building to access the main hospital entrance. The new car park entrance on Rowland Hill street will also remove the previous awkward and potentially dangerous mixture of pedestrian access to the north facing radiotherapy entrance and vehicular entrance to the old car park.
