					light to my house and others on the street. It is well known that Imperial Works intends to convert use to residential, and one such application has already been rejected. The style of the intended roof extension looks very suited to a future change of use. As we saw with Brinsmead, it was only allowed to fully convert to residential use after several planning applications. One cant help thinking that a repeat situation might happen here. And I must say there is not one resident of Ryland Road, to my knowledge, who would not object in the strongest terms to a change of use at Imperial Works. On occasion, residents of Ryland Road have had application for dorm loft extensions rejected by your office. There would be a lack of parity and fairness should a much larger and more obtrusive extension to Imperial Works gain the permission it is seeking.
