Details of the pre-application advice received:

Dear Dean – early indications are that my department would accept in principle a small jib doorway between the front room and the bathroom corridor. This would need to be concealed from the inside and non-historic from the outside of the room (to differentiate it). Your client might prefer to retain the use of the principal doorway, as otherwise strangers inside the room might struggle to find the exit. In any case, nothing more structural than locking the principal door is acceptable. Please could you submit drawings of the jib doorway at 1:20? If this detail is OK, I'll then ask you to resubmit your whole proposal, incorporating this doorway, whatever the final proposals are for the floors, explanation of the kitchen services and a method statement for the porch steps. As I mentioned, any proposal to replace the hall floor with stone would need to be firmly backed up with a substantial amount of detailed and irrefutable historical evidence. I also believe that inserting material underneath the floorboards will have knock-on effects on the skirting boards, doors, window aprons, etc, that will be very difficult to mitigate and will cause harm to the special interest of the house. If floorboards have to come up to renew the radiators, a method statement will also be required. For differentiation, any additional internal partitions should be non-corniced and differently skirting boarded, and annotated as such on the drawings, ditto the new bathroom doorway to bedroom 2.
