There is dread in the air in this small community in the area of the 'T' junction formed by Glastonbury St with Ravenshaw St

A Survey team has been observed: obviously a plan to exploit the space referred to is being drawn up.

Let me advise you of a "fault" in the built-on contours of this area which could lead to extremely deleterious shifts affecting this property

The pressure effected by the building of structures larger + heavier than the "lean to" in situ can have adverse effects of the ground on which my property stands. The contour was formed by flood flow. It is markedly delineated by the fact that my property floor level is some feet higher than the level of the garden of the properties to my left. My great fear is that an improper, ie. new, weight / pressure input in properties abutting mine will tilt the historic balance - we're talking centuries here - and render the foundations unstable and, thus, unsuitable to be rebuilt on. It is vital that no envisaged property be allowed to include a basement.
