This block of houses is built on a gradient, and the size of the appropriate height step between houses can be seen by comparing the levels of existing windows. From the drawings, I estimate it to be about 50cm
					The proposed mansard roof line appears almost level with that of its neighbour at No.78, with a step of only about 10cm. Thus it should be lowered by about 40cm.
					Furthermore, on the front elevation, the mansard is very close to the parapet, and may well be (inappropriately) visible at street level.
					In summary, the roof extension should be lowered, and it should be ensured that it is not visible at street level.
