There is funding available from the government and there is no reason not to disclose the financial aspects of this application. Is one of the councillors benefitting personally? is this why we are unable to see the finances of this publicly funded project? Please can the identity of the person or persons hiding this information be published so that a full investigation can be conducted? It might make interesting reading.</p> <p>The school building is 20 minutes walk away from the rest of the school. How do you expect children to arrive ready to be educated if they have to walk that far.</p> <p>I have an 18 month old child and would expect him to be able to go to the school directly behind our flat, but as of this moment (near the end of the consultation period), there is no criteria to state if he will be close enough to the school to gain a place.
