1. Cherry - Reduce the lateral growth overhanging 25 using a tripod ladder and a longarm pruner.
2. Lime - Crown thin by 20% and remove deadwood. Crown raise to 3m over the pavement. Leave all of the basal suckers and stem growth.
3. Mulberry - No Action

- 4. Horse Chestnut - Remove one low limb overhanging the road.
- 5. Horse Chestnut - No Action.
- 6. Lime - No Action.
- 7. Horse Chestnut - Reduce the long branch pointing towards 19 Lanland Gardens, using a tripod ladder and long arm pruner.
- 6a. Acacia stump - Fell to ground level. Leaving the log wood cut into 300mm lengths.
- 8. Plane Plane - Crown raise to 6m over the road.
- 8a. Norway Maple - Remove low branch.
- 9. Elder - Remove low branch.
- 10. Cherry - Remove two low branches.
- 11. Hazel - Remove all older growth leaving the younger stem to take their place.
- 12. Oak - Remove the low branches toward the house by 2 - 3m + remove the ropes and old wooden planks. Crown raise to 6m over the road
- 13. Remove the suppressed stem and lightly reshape the remainder where necessary.
- 14 - 16 Limes - Reduce the side overhanging the garden back to previous reduction points and one branch a little further. Crown remove basal growths and raise to 6m.
- 17. Hornbeam - Crown reduce by 2 - 3m, remove deadwood and reshape to leave a natural outline.
- 18. ~~Privet adjacent to the Limes cut back the overhang.~~
