Indeed one of the reasons I chose to live in St Pancras chambers was the charm of a beautiful Grade 1 listed building and I was thrilled that the restoration of the Building had been done with such good taste and true to the original Architecture. Truthfully the annexe to the Town Hall is one of the ugliest buildings around St Pancras, and although I felt that selling the Annexe did not necessarily represent good long term value for Camden's ratepayers, I was not too upset to hear it may be demolished, notwithstanding the inconvenience any building work would create by necessity. Indeed I had naively hoped that current planning rules and architectural taste may produce a building which is somewhat more suitable in character for this wonderful area. What came as a total surprise to me and many other neighbours was the sheer scale and height of the building, which will create a much larger Blot on the area than the current building. This are is unique to London, containing the Grade 1 listed St Pancras Chambers and Station, Grade 1 listed Kings Cross Station and lovely original Camden Town Hall (grade 2 listed and immediately adjoining the annexe site) also many of the buildings around Argyle Street and the Square are listed. I should also wish to mention that almost all the buildings along the Road are 3 Storeys high rather than the 12 storeys that are planned by the developers. One can see from the various drawings and mock ups that the proposed Tall Building will be totally disproportionate to the area I am also somewhat disappointed that the new development offers no benefit to the Local community, the area already has a range of Hotels which together with the Station offer a rich range of dining facilities, but other than these, I cannot see a
