2014/7951/P	Robin Derrick	1 Perren Street	04/02/2015 01:30:21	OBJ	<p>I own and live in the property next door to the application and I recommend not granting this application on the following grounds</p> <p>1) OVERLOOKING While my property is not shown on the application plans the proposed roof extension would overlook my house and give a clear view into my bedroom.</p> <p>2) SAFETY The fire escape which the application proposes to clad is also the fire escape of my building and not in sole ownership of the applicant and the cladding as proposed would make it impossible for me or my family to use the fire escape.</p> <p>3) LOSS OF LIGHT There is a narrow passage between the two buildings where I have windows and cladding the escape will reduce considerably the amount of light to the back of my house.</p> <p>4) RIGHT OF WAY The proposed cladding to the fire escape stands on land over which I have a right of way – and contravenes that right of way by restricting my access to the escape LAND REGISTRY NGL343277 17/11/78</p> <p>5) ACCESS This application implies change of use of the building to residential and at present access is limited to either end of the building. At the south end, and the most popular entrance access is across my property, via a set of gates owned by me.
