Design

The proposal is to built a Studio at the end of the existing garden of 101A Gloucester Avenue, which is a Lower Ground floor flat.

The proposed footprint of the Studio is 14.9 sqm and its external finished height is 2.5 m high. Our intention is to create a Studio that it would be used as a Study/Office for the family occupying the Lower Ground Floor flat.

The materials to be used externally include reclaimed French type doors and painted lapboard panelling. A fixed rooflight is proposed to be located in the middle of the Studio roof. The proposed roof will be cladded with painted lapboard to match with the rest of the shed.
