Objection/comment

While we have no objection to the principle of a mansard roof extension in this location, which is situated mid-terrace between other extensions, we have two objections to the design proposed.

- 1. We object to the destruction of the âbutterflyâ parapet at the rear. We comment that Camdenâs Planning Guidance, Design, at 5.19 specifically requires the retention of these butterfly parapets. Loss of butterfly parapets is specifically recognized as harmful to the character and appearance of the PH CA, see PH21 in the CA appraisal. We would not object to the use of a glass balustrade, as proposed, to the glazed door, so long as it is located behind the retained parapet.
- 2. We object to the form and details of the front opening. We notice that there is no assessment of its visibility from the street. A pair of openings would better follow the design of

the existing house. The proposed âboxing around to match the slate colourâ does not follow Camdenâs guidance at 5.18 which refers to the importance of using high quality materials because of the visibility of roof extensions.
