Objection/comment

- 1. We have no objection to the infill of the backyard.
- 2. We object to the erection of the glazed screen to the rear, which would be oppressive for the neighbours, limiting their already restricted outlook to the rear. It is characteristic of the conservation area that rear views are often limited: that makes the views out even more valuable, and the sense of enclosure should not be diminished further.
- 3. We object to the proposed storage enclosure to the platform to the front area. The building is located at the corner of Chalcot Square, facing the flank of Chalcot Crescent, and the start of Sharpleshall Street: these are all Listed Buildings, and their settings form a confluence at this point. In this context, the proposal is inappropriate in materials and form. It is more suited to a rear garden shed than the townscape of the junction of three groups of urban Listed Buildings. It is, by reason of its materials and form, harmful to the character and appearance of the conservation area which it neither preserves nor enhances. We would be happy to consider alternatives which responded more thoughtfully to the character of the area.

We note that the form of the railings is specific to this group of houses, and should be included as part of the proposal.
