Works proposed are the excavation and foundation work to allow the existing damaged brick boundary wall to be rebuilt. This will take place within the root protection zone of the protected lime tree in the garden of No.1. The contractor undertaking the works will employ the services of a gualified arboriculturist to prepare a full method statement for these works and to be in attendance during all groundworks, ensuring they are carried out in full accordance with BS 5837:2012. All excavations will be hand dug, with roots identified and protected during construction. The new pad and beam foundation is designed to accommodate the roots of the protected tree, with pad positions adjusted on-site to suit. Temporary protection and hoardings will also be provided to prevent any damage to the lime tree trunk or branches. The contractor will be employed directly by LB Camden from their approved list and managed by LB Camden's approved consultants.
