



Dear Camden,

I object to the proposal 2014/6250/L on the following grounds:

1. The opening of a coffee outlet directly in front of the Coffee Cup, a coffee outlet since 1953 is both pointless and rather provocative.
2. This part of Hampstead is often overcrowded, especially on weekends. There is only a narrow amount of pavement between the proposed site and the Coffee Cup's seated area. This will cause the a blockage and obstruction of a public highway as soon as the smallest queues form and so isn't practical.
