The leylandii were originally planted as a hedge, however they have become significantly overgrown and their condition has deteriorated as a result. They also provide excessive shade to the garden and the communal area by the front door to the block of flats. Proposed replacement is with a hedge of a more appropriate proportion. There are NO proposal works to the plane tree (marked on the sketch plan) next to the leylandii plants.
