Dear Sirs,

The Cedar tree in my neighbour's [29 Grove Place] small front garden is causing me concern.

The tree stands within 2.8 metres of of the frontage of the adjacent house and within 2.0 metres of the Party Fence.

Several years ago the adjoining owner's builder cut the main top stem out of the top of the tree and as a consequence new growth has tended to be sideways.

Currently the tree spreads over the party fence and over my roof, the crown is grossly over grown, it is drastically reduces daylight to one bedroom and the kitchen.

The spread over the roof leaves a litter of needles and encourages the grows of moss in the damp conditions-which will lead to deterioration of the tiles.

I need the growth to be well controlled in an appropriate way. I need the crown to be reduced about 40 0/0, prune back to the party fence and prune overhang from the roof.
