Specification for works to horse chestnut tree in rear garden

The tree was inspected by an independent arboriculturalist on 15 July 2014.

He recommended work be undertaken for the following reason and according to the following specification:

Purpose of work

If left to grow the two side limbs of the tree will become increasingly end weighted as they grow outwards towards the available light. The purpose of the proposed work is to shorten the branches concerned to reduce the end weight and lessen the degree to which they extend beyond the rest of the crown and catch the wind.

Specification for work

1) To shorten the two main limbs on the left and right hand sides of the tree, seen from the back of the house, by up to 4m back to the most suitable side branches to avoid leaving stumps and retain a soft, natural silhouette.

The suggested pruning points are indicated on the photograph provided.

2) To shorten other branch ends only as necessary to retain a natural shape.


* All tree work is to be carried out in accordance with BS 3998:2010, Recommendation for Treeworks, and any other relevant standards.

It is essential that the contractor has appropriate third party and public liability insurances.

The tree is in a conservation area.

- 13. As the tree is in a conservation area Camden Council will need to be given the normal six weeks notice. It would be reasonable for them not to object to shortening the two extended limbs. However in my experience they would not allow an overall reduction unless there were compelling reasons for it and they are unlikely to regard shade in a garden as sufficient justification.
