Dear James,

Thank you for your letter of Feb 6th re the above application.

I am the owner of Davis Cottage and I wish to record my strong objection to this planning application. I do this on the basis that it is an example of over-development which ^{in this case} ~~will~~ lead to an increased overlooking into my kitchen/living room and garden from the additional windows serving the new habitable rooms. The additional floors at upper levels would feel oppressive & would dominate my property.

In short, this development would harm my living conditions and invade my privacy to an unacceptable degree.

It may be relevant to mention that I am 83, and suffer from severe arthritis - (a Blue Badge holder, etc.) - and so am restricted to the use of the ground floor, which, in effect, means to the kitchen/living room, for much of the day. I have installed a large glass skylight in it, with electrically controlled ventilation, which works well, but would, I suppose, be adversely affected by the proposed development which is very close. It's interesting, in this context, that the applicant does not show where his boundary meets mine in his drawings.
