Conversion and change of use from ground floor part restaurant (Use Class A3) and first and second floor part 4 bedroom maisonette (Use Class C3) to self-contained restaurant (Use Class A3), erection of half storey first floor rear extension, new shopfront and awning, alterations to fenestration on rear elevation, enlarged roof light to rear extension and new roof plant to rear extension.

The Council has considered your application and decided to refuse planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed development would result in the net loss of residential floorspace which would compromise the Council's ability to meet the housing demands of the projected household growth in the future, contrary to policies CS1 (Distribution of growth) and CS6 (Providing quality homes) of the London Borough of Camden Local



Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP2 (Making full use of Camden's capacity for housing) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies and policy 3.14 (Existing housing) of The London Plan 2011.
