Planning (Listed Building and Conservation Areas) Act 1990

Listed Building Consent Granted

Address: 41 Highgate West Hill London N6 6LS

Proposal: Works to the second floor rear balcony of the main house, including; proposals for a perimeter rail to the terrace, metalwork to the three bay steps, and installation of brickwork.

Drawing Nos: 22_3000 (LOCATION PLAN), 3301 Rev TP (Existing Information), 3310 Rev TP2 (Plans and Sections), 3310 Rev TP2 (Side Bay), 3311 Rev TP2 (Mid Bay), 3314 Rev TP2 (Elevations), 3320 Rev TP2 (Perimeter Rail), 3321 Rev TP2 (Perimeter Rail).

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant Listed Building Consent subject to the following conditions:

Conditions and Reasons:

1 The works hereby permitted shall be begun not later than the end of three years from the date of this consent.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 18 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.



2 The works hereby approved are only those specifically indicated on the drawings referred to above.

Reason: In order to safeguard the special architectural and historic interest of the building in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

3 All new work and work of making good shall be carried out to match the original work as closely as possible in materials and detailed execution.

Reason: In order to safeguard the special architectural and historic interest of the building in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

Informatives:

1 Reasons for granting listed building consent.

The proposed railing and balustrades to the rear second floor terrace of the main house will not obscure any significant architectural features or otherwise visually harm the building, and are considered acceptable in terms of location, proportions and design. The alterations proposed will not result in the loss of original or otherwise historical fabric and will not affect the integrity of the building. The proposal is thus considered to be sympathetic to the special architectural or historic interest of the listed building.

The site's planning history and relevant appeals have been taken into account when coming to this decision. No representations were received as a result of consultation.

Special regard has been attached to the desirability of preserving the listed building and its features of special architectural or historic interest, under s.66 of the Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act (ERR) 2013.

As such, the proposal is in general accordance with policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policy DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies. The proposed development also accords with policy 7.8 of the London Plan 2011, and paragraphs 14, 17 and 126-141 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

- 2 Your proposals may be subject to control under the Building Regulations and/or the London Buildings Acts which cover aspects including fire and emergency escape, access and facilities for people with disabilities and sound insulation between dwellings. - 3 Noise from demolition and construction works is subject to control under the Control of Pollution Act 1974. You must carry out any building works that can be heard at the boundary of the site only between 08.00 and 18.00 hours Monday to Friday and 08.00 to 13.00 on Saturday and not at all on Sundays and Public You are advised to consult the Council's Noise and Licensing Holidavs. Enforcement Team, Camden Town Hall, Argyle Street, WC1H 8EQ (Tel.
