Secondly, and more importantly, the reduction of size of the pub and its redesign will completely destroy the character and atmosphere of the pub - and may well make it unviable. The pub's current design has a well defined separation of the two main rooms, tap room and lounge providing a choice of areas to drink, and also allows for parties, performances and especially the numerous sports teams to meet & play without causing disturbance to the other room. Far too many pubs in Camden have closed (40 or so this century) or been redeveloped into places that have little appeal to the local residents of Camden. The Admiral Mann was a very busy pub and was used by a wide cross-section of the local society, ages, genders and races - something that is rarely seen in pubs now.
