Your comments on the planning application

We object to this development on the following grounds. There is no guarantee or assurance on the residents not acquiring parking permits through some other means or the Council not granting parking permits in the future. In addition to this there is no guarantee that the residents will not have visitors with vehicles â all this being more congestion and more detrimental to the current traffic and parking facilities that under strain already as a direct result of Camden Councilâs policy. The paramount objection to this development irrespective of any design or feature element is that it does not facilitate any car parking. Without

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accommodating at least 1 vehicle per residence, the development is detrimental to the conservation area.

Our other objections are:

(a) the additional residents requirements for medical, schooling and other local services which will be overloaded and make it more difficult for current residents to not only get doctorsâ appointments but also to get a spot in their local school â Fleet Primary;

(b) the look and feel of the proposed development is not in keeping with the conservation area of Lawn Road and Upper Park Road;

(c) there will be increased air and noise pollution with additional residents, vehicles and the ;

(d) traffic is already congested on Lawn Road but at least currently there is a bay for vehicles to pull into to allow traffic to pass. However, this will be removed with the current development thus creating a great level of traffic congestion on Lawn Road;

(e) also the amenities available to the local area should not be removed, such as the wonderful mosaic mural and the community centre which could be upgraded and used by all members of the community effectively.
