NW1 3JP	19/03/2015 17:20:39	OBJ	<p>I think this is a very bad idea and I strongly oppose to the planning application.</p> <p>The current location of the refuse storage area is in an ideal place as this is in the same area as most residents use to enter and exit the building.</p> <p>The current location of the refuse storage area is also very accessible to elderly and disabled residents of Woodhall.</p> <p>If the refuse storage area is relocated to the western side of the building it will be too far from where most people enter and exit the building and is likely to cause many residents to dump their refuse sacks in the eastern Robert Street/ Hampstead Road entrance as they leave the building (the former refuse storage area if the application is successful.</p> <p>This may also cause issues for elderly and disabled tenants as the new location is likely to be accessed only by a stair case where the current location of the refuse area is step free.</p>

Secondly we have at this time direct access to the bin chamber via the lift which is very convenient for older residents to use and having the bin chamber outside woodhall will require us to take our refuse and recycling to outside in Stanhope street. And what about the bulky items that the residents would use the lift to take directly to the bin chamber ie bedings and mattresses cookers and fridges and now all these items will be left in our corridors because residents will not be able to dispose of them properly</p> <p>Thirdly the planning application is vague and no plan or map has been posted on your website so that we can see the actual proposed location. For all I can imagine you are planning to erect this new area in our allocated garden area which will make our recreation area much smaller and a lot smellier for all the residents. The other buildings in Regent's Park state benefit from shoots and lifts for the disposal of their refuse but woodhall not only does not benefit from the refuse shoots but also will lose its access to the in house refuse facilities which we have enjoyed for so many years this is in my opinion going back wards and will make the facilities harder to reach and after so much trouble that we have gone through because of netleys project all the noise and pollution</p> <p>And having our hot water cut out every other day this will be another insult from the council for our patience for these reasons I strongly object to the proposed planning application.</p> <p>Regards</p>
