I would like to object to this planning application for the following reasons:

1) This is a conservation area, and the design that has been put forward is completely out of character with that area. The facade design is second-rate and not well thought out. The new building mass will significantly impose upon Leverton Place, a Victorian cobbled street. If the proposal goes ahead the enlarged building will seriously reduce light levels and change the quality of the lane.

2) The new large windows will also mean a lot less privacy in the neighbouring houses on Leverton Street and Leverton Place.

I am particularly concerned about the new large windows looking towards the back of the houses on Leighton Road. We frequently experience problems with noise and intrusion from the existing roof terrace. I do not think permission should be given for first floor-roof terraces so close to neighbouring houses.

I request that the application is refused planning permission.
