Dear Sir/Madam

As immediate neighbour of the proposed property development above, and as resident of 123 Broadhurst Gardens for the past 35 years, we write to express our family's objection to the planning application. We object to the proposed plan on the grounds of:

- Loss of privacy: the proposed balcony would overlook our private garden, and significantly reduce the privacy that it currently has given there are no other directly overlooking balconies/terraces. We highlight that the existing balcony on the 1st floor is low enough that it does not significantly overlook our garden particularly in the spring/summer when the view over our garden is blocked by trees/bushes. Whereas the proposed new balcony on the 4th floor would overlook our garden much more significantly, and that would be the case all year round (i.e. even during the summer months)
- Noise nuisance: the creation of the balcony could potentially significantly increase noise nuisance given it is immediately adjacent to our property and would overlook our garden, as mentioned above.


