E.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with 1 standard ash in the same place.

1. Reduce height and spread of old pear (perry) tree by 25% to shape and make safe for the future. Work needs doing due to some hollow in trunk and some canker in main branches. Due to age of tree only eventual alternative would be felling which we absolutely prefer to avoid.

2.Similar (i.e. 25% reduction of spread/height) in nearby holly tree again due to issues posed by increasingly hollow trunk.

Both actions recommended by experienced tree surgeon, Antony Wylam, who would undertake work.

Location of trees - the only pear and only holly tree in back garden of 23 Grove Terrace, both towards right hand side (from back door exit) near party wall to 22 Grove Terrace)

Camden welcome to inspect trees in question if you so wish. I work from home so flexible on times to suit Camden.
