The lack of light will also have an adverse affect on the shared rear garden making it difficult to grow many plants, it is already restricted. My flat is already a bit gloomy and this will only add to it, and as disabled housebound person I don't get to see much light anyway, this will make matters even worse; I can see it being necessary to have the lights on during the afternoon!  Secondly, I would like to object on the grounds that this proposed building will add to the "concreting" over of soil which is needed to prevent run-off and potential flooding, I do now want any flooding to my rear door, which has never happened before.  Thirdly, I object to the proposed building over of green space, which is essential to wildlife in the area and enables there to be a "green corridor", whereby birds and animals can move from space to space, if this is blocked even partly it will mean less wildlife opportunities in the surrounding area. It may be a relatively small area but as a Member of the RSPB, and several other wildlife organisations, I know every small part of the "puzzle" of green land adds up, therefore even relatively small proposals like this should not go ahead as they are part of a larger picture of protection and potential for wildlife to blossom and go toward the protection of individual species.
