Re Admiral Mann Public House

Dear Sir / Madame

Please except this letter as a formal objection to planning application to the Admiral Mann Public House in Margeaux Place.

I am a licensed Black Taxi-cab driver and have used the Admiral Mann for the last 15 years after my original "local" The City of London shut down only to be sold to developers who turned the pub into flats. I then started to use "The Lion" in North Road, Six months after the City of London was shut so it was The Lion which was also sold to developers who turned the pub into flats. Both of these ~~the~~ pubs were within 400 meters of the Admiral Mann. Also the Copenhagen on Camden Road and Rosie M'Cann on York Way. Both sold to Property developers once again M'Cann turned into flats. The Murry arms in Murry St / Camden Sq less than a 10 minute walk from the Admiral Mann sold turned into Mini market with flats above. So as you can see our whole local community pubs have been decimated over the last decade by greedy property developers who turn our community pubs into ~~flats~~ ^{which} no local working class person could afford to buy in a million years. The Admiral Mann was our last community pub in our area.

The clientele ranged from Solicitors, accountants, musicians Postman, local retailers, school teachers and what a bloody good time we all had together. In my 15 years of drinking in time I know of only one occasion where the police

Had to be called and that was a stranger
wandered in and went behind the bar, and refused to
come out. Never any violence in the pub. Visiting foreign
supporters who were playing Arsenal in the Champions League
always came in the Mann. Voters to the Corner house hotel
always found their way to the Mann. Football teams
Darts teams, Music nights, Karaoke nights, ~~fund~~
fund raising events, Impromptu music sessions ~~with~~
World famous band maestro "Pete Stanley" Weddings,
engagements, Funerals, Parties, Card games, Bridge, and of
course the weekly Quiz. Our Football predictor Quiz which
runs the length of the football season with a first prize
of £3,500 had 200 entries every single week.

I'm am sure you can see by now that this wasn't
any old pub, this was a pub that is so so special
to the local community. The current plans show a reduction
in floor space by 40%. This is totally unacceptable. We
want our pub back and back as it was in September last
year. So come on Camden Council show the whole community
that you've got a pair! and refuse planning permission
of our beloved "Admiral Mann."
