residents association committee.

Our neighbourhood committee has solicited the opinions of neighbours in the local area and based on this input objects to this application

We agree with the comments from the Heath and Hampstead Society regarding the presentation and detail of this application which are not detailed.

Planning Application Details

In particular, we are concerned that the proposed basement is large and deep and extends beyond the footprint of the house. As a neighbourhood association we resist large and deep basement excavations like this because they are a risk to the hydrological flows in our neighbourhood which is on a slope with clav.

This development is inconsistent with planning policy which is moving to limit outsize basement developments such as this one.

There are no diagrams which show whether the depth of this development will extend below the foundations of neighbouring properties which is a risk to neighbours.

The application description states that the basement is under the house footprint; it is no such thing; it clearly extends 3 metres into the rear garden.

We disagree with the statement that the structure would not have any significant effect on neighbouring buildings and note there is no reference to the Burland Scale and inadequate evidence to support this assertion.

This development needs to be scaled back to a moderate depth and kept within the existing footprint of the house rather than extending out into the garden. Iceberg houses are an objection in principle by our neighbours.
