**Response:** The building is already taking place and by comparing plans, existing and proposed there are some glaring differences on site. The mansard roof details vary significantly from previous plans, there are large roof top structures in place, presumably some type of ventilation or roof light. We believe the height of the development is greater than residents were led to believe. The rear elevation of the previous building had a small (very small) opening at ground floor. The previous plans show these small openings and refer to re-using the existing openings with the installation of opaque fixed glazing. The newly constructed openings at the rear are significantly bigger. Having larger openings on the ground floor will affect us in our gardens and limit our privacy, even with opaque glass. Currently we have a shed structure and planting along the property wall and wish to continue to enjoy our gardens. No other facades along the Mews have large openings at ground floor overlooking neighbours in the gardens.
