The proposed roof extension, by reason of its location, scale and bulk would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the building, the terrace as a whole and the Mansfield Conservation Area, contrary to policies CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, policy DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local



Development Framework Development Policies 2010 - 2025.
