The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** advertisement consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The internally illuminated advertisement would by reason of its size, inappropriate design, prominent location between the 3rd and 5th floor and method of illumination would harm the character and appearance of the host building and streetscene contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting High Quality Places and Conserving Our Heritage) of Camden's Local Development Framework Core Strategy 2010, as well as Policy DP24 (Securing High Quality Design) Camden's Local Development Framework Policies 2010-2025.
