We object to this proposal for the following reasons:

The wall dividing the hall from the living room on the Raised Ground Floor should be doubled for reasons of sound insulation as the proposal is for two self-contained units.

The proposed section should be drawn through the north side of the house so as the show the position of the proposed door and shortened window above. This door seems to cross the floor of the First Floor. So the proposal needs to be clarified.

There will be overlooking of the next door house, No 135, unless the party wall is raised. If it is raised it may cause loss of sunlight for No 135.

In the Application Form, Section 9, new materials and finishes are not specified as being N/A. This is not good enough for a proposal to make changes to a listed building.
