					The extension and terrace will look directly into my kitchen and living room and the "obscure glazing" on the lower part of the windows that is proposed to minimise privacy loss will not resolve the loss of privacy to my flat as the extension will be on the same level as my first floor flat so the occupiers of both properties will be at eye to eye level. I have photographs of the view from my flat onto 5 Hemstal Road to help the committee understand my objection and would be very happy to share these with the committee to illustrate the issue.
					At a minimum I would request that the planning application be amended to include a commitment to maintain or extend the current treeline to preserve the privacy of my flat and any similarly affected homes on Dynham Road.
