Further, the applicant should be required to propose a more traditional shopfront, as required in the Seven Dials Renaissance Study, which Camden adopted for planning purposes. The CGCA notes that fragments survive of an elegant late-18th century shop front including the pilasters flanking the house door, and the dentil cornice above the fascia. The house door and fanlight are good Georgian features. The original design of the whole shop front could easily be restored on the evidence of these surviving parts. Such an historically accurate restoration would enhance the Conservation Area.
