Local property values would plummet. Rentals would be impossible for at least two years  2. Neighbouring and local residents and organisations (Air, Olav) would be heavily affected by removal of spoil via a very narrow access road that would have to be widened.  3. A double height basement would affect ground stability and drainage adversely affecting neighbours especially in Rosslyn Hill downhill of the site.  4. A connecting tunnel is an outrageous proposal  5.
