The current site has been disused for some time now, and the proposal will bring the land back into economic use. At the moment, the access to the canal is poor via a staircase in poor condition. The proposals improvements to the public realm, should raise the standard of access, although provision should be made for bikes and other users on wheels. The stretch of canal at this point can be a place where anti-social behavior is a problem, and having a building with workers and users of the cafe should make this part less attractive to those who take part in the anti-social behaviors. I do not have any concerns about the actual building, but I am concerned about the possibility that once this section of the canal towpath is no longer used by some of more aggressive drug dealers and drunks, then that activity will move to the other side of the bridge on Kentish Town Road. I suggest that either this scheme or an additional scheme, should include some provision for CCTV or other security measures on both sides of Kentish Town Road bridge to avoid this.
