1 The submitted details of the green roof, including the species type and substrate specifications are considered acceptable and meet the requirements of condition 11.

Special attention has been paid to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the conservation area, under s.72 of the Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act (ERR) 2013.
