The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission

Informative(s):

The submitted details of the tree protection measures are considered acceptable and to meet the requirements of condition 4. The works shall involve hand digging of the upper 100mm of soil and any tree roots encountered that are thicker than 25mm in diameter shall be protected and retained.

Special attention has been paid to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the conservation area, under s.72 of the Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act (ERR) 2013.



As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policy CS14 and CS15 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policies DP24, DP25 and DP26 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies. The proposed development also accords with policies 7.4, 7.6 and 7.8 of the London Plan March 2015, consolidated with alterations since 2011; and paragraphs 14, 17, 56-66 and 126-141 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
