The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The alteration to the front roof parapet, by reason of its design, loss of historic feature and relationship with the existing roof form of the host property, neighbouring property and surrounding terrace, harms the appearance of the host building, disrupts its symmetry with the surrounding terrace and creates a negative impact on the character and appearance of the wider Kentish Town Conservation Area. The development is therefore contrary to policies CS5 (Managing the impact of growth and development) and CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving



Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

ENFORCEMENT ACTION TO BE TAKEN

The Council has authorised the Planning Department to instruct the Borough Solicitor to issue an Enforcement Notice alleging breach of planning control.
