The CGCA objects to the continuing loss of office space in Covent Garden and we note that this location already has consent for two floors of residential. In particular, we are concerned about the loss of small office space. Such space supports small- and medium-sized businesses, which often are the types of innovative, creative and knowledge-based economy jobs that London and the UK have made it a policy to attract. Without adequate space in Central London, these businesses cannot flourish or even exist in the Capital. We note Camden's concern about the loss of office space, as well, which the Council outlined in its response to the DCLG Technical Consultation in September 2014.

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
