On that basis, we have no objection to the internal alterations, although we believe strongly that any original material should be retained, as this is a Grade II* listed building.	
					If the excavation of rear courtyard and front lightwell are intended to be included, then we object in the strongest terms, for the reasons set out in our responses to the existing applications 2015/1217/P and 2015/1695/L.	
					Even if the application is limited to internal alterations, we believe the construction management plan submitted with the application is completely inadequate. The very cursory statement provided by the applicant is completely inadequate for the scale of the proposed works. For example, there is no explanation of how traffic will be managed on the narrow, one-lane Grove Terrace.
