We write on behalf of our client University College London Hospitals (UCLH) NHS Foundation Trust, to apply to discharge condition 36 of the permission 2013/8192/P. Condition 36 within the decision notice states the following.

Condition 36

"Prior to the commencement of development, other than site clearance, an impact studies of the existing water supply infrastructure shall be submitted to, and approved in writing by, the local planning authority in conjunction with Thames Water. The studies should determine the magnitude of any new additional capacity required in the system and a suitable connection point."
