Dear David,

Further to your letter dated 24th April 2015 regarding the Midlands Goods Shed (MGS) on King's Cross development (planning reference 2014/1533/P and 2014/1436/L), I am writing to confirm that such works are considered to be Non material and therefore you would not require any further planning consent to carry out such amendments.

The alterations include:

- Relocating the approved primary store entrance one bay to the north;
- Relocating the approved signage zone to the same location; and
- Converting an approved fire escape door into a general exit door for the supermarket.

The works proposed do not include any new openings, and they simply involve swapping an approved entrance with sliding doors with a fully glazed infill as well as altering a previously approved steel door with a glazed door. Therefore such works are not considered to have any impact on the Listed Building due to their minor nature.
