This proposal would set a dangerous precedent destroying the character of this part of the conservation area.</p> <p>Neighbours would be obliged to look at, and down on, an ugly flat-roof building out of keeping with the Victorian houses and mansion blocks of the 'triangle'.</p> <p>The use of stone for the proposed extension when all other buildings of the area are weathered red brick is difficult to understand.</p> <p>The applicant states that no trees in adjoining areas will be affected by the proposal but a very large tree in the neighbouring garden is only feet away from the boundary wall and trees in the communal garden are likewise very near to the property..</p> <p>I urge the council to reject the proposal and protect this conservation area from over-development. .</p>
