The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

1 Insufficient information has been submitted to fully demonstrate how the changes in levels and floors as shown in elevation and section would affect the character and fabric of the Grade II listed building, and thus would be likely to be harmful to its special interest and character. As such the details fail to comply with the requirements of policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our



heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
