Thank you for your letter of 30 April 2015 notifying Historic England of the scheme relating to the above site.

Having considered the information received and found that the proposals will not conflict with the advice previously provided on the related applications (please see our comments regarding cases 2014/5699/L and 2014/5338/P), we do not wish to offer any further comments on this occasion.


