Dear Seonaid Carr,

I am writing with my objection to UCLU Phase 5, Capper Street & Huntley Street, WC1.

As a resident of Gordon Mansions I strongly object to the aforementioned planning application. I think it is dreadful that hospitals are torn down and rebuilt without consideration to the health of residents and without regard to the years of pollution that extensive works will bring. It is most unfair that this has happened three times on Huntley street alone. No sooner is one project completed than the next begins.

The last scheme blighted the neighbourhood with dust and traffic and now it is proposed to build directly opposite our home. The levels of pollution are already high and are effecting our health and well being, the thought of having to face another extended period of demolition and construction with all the associated tensions is unbearable.

This is only my **principal objection** to the scheme. I find it difficult to look beyond another extended period of dirty, noisy construction to a time when it is complete. The prospect of the disruption that a completed hospital will bring is hard to face.

The whole area is losing its heart squeezed between the constantly shifting hospital and the looming university. It is unfair to the residents of Gordon Mansions.
