Demolish and rebuild retaining walls, paths, and front porch for the property which has been extensively undermined by a water main leak. This is the subject of an insurance claim. Part of the work involves partially rebuilding the driveway and relaying a permanent mains water pipe. One retaining wall at the front of the property has already been demolished due to danger of collapse. Intension is to rebuild according to recommended structural engineer's design involving a concrete layer, but face this with the existing bricks which will be reclaimed. The intention is to replace with like walls. Existing wall pillars are capped with concrete caps. These will be replaced with similar artifiical sandstone caps. Existing external light fittings will be replaced with similar black Victorian style ones that are more efficient. Existing paving are to the front door needs to be waterproofed and replaced.

Addition of 6 of the same to provide extra step lighting at entry way to building. Addition of 3 of the same on pathway at side of building. Finish will be "sandstone" colour to best match brickwork and light-coloured stone pathway at front.

300x300 Grey-green slate tiles, laid approx 2004. Tiles need replacing due to cracking and lifting after water damage.

Sandstone tiles, to blend with buildings on either side and across road. Tiles will be 600x600. Precise stone is Futurestone Quartz Beige. This is a manufactured sandstone to increase lifespan and minimise staining. Existing concrete pier caps on boundary fence will be replaced with sandstone to blend with new tiles and with surrounding buildings.
