Mature tree. This tree is leaning out to the light and is typical for the species. The tree has been propped. The tree has shifted on its root plate, there is a noticeable bulge in the ground to the North and the limb that is propped is definitely lower than it used to be. To retain this highly visual amenity tree but also reduce the likleihood of root plate failure or windthrow, the suggested works are: To reduce the lateral spread to the South (over the boundary and road) by 2-2.5m, reduce the overall height by 2m to shape, clean out crown, remove deadwood.


